Educational Content

- *Is The MedTech Conference the right forum for this session?*
- Will critical, timely and practical information be shared?

Relevance & Timeliness

• Will this be a hot topic in September 2019?

Novel Topic

Does this session proposal offer new and important information?

Speaker Expertise

- Are these dynamic and expert speakers?
- Are there one or more top, high quality speakers on session? CEOs, key thought leaders, policy makers and/or people of influence?

Speaker Diversity

- Are speakers from different geographic regions, sectors, companies and genders?
- Do speakers represent multiple views?


