PD&R Opens Competition for Healthy Homes Secretary's Award

HUD's Office of Policy Development and Research ([PD&R](#)) has posted a "call for entries" for the [2020 HUD Secretary's Award for Healthy Homes](#). The application deadline for the award, which recognizes excellence in making indoor environments healthier, is **March 10, 2020**.

For the award, HUD is partnering with the National Environmental Health Association ([NEHA](#)) in a common vision to create healthier home environments by working across health, environment, and housing sectors. The award highlights some of the nation's most significant work on the relationship between living environments and resident health across six categories: public housing, multifamily housing, policy innovation, cross-program coordination, innovation in education and communications, and research.
