HUD Reminds PHAs to Request Corrections Regarding OpFund Preliminary Eligibility

In an email today to the Financial Management Division (FMD) [mailing list](#), HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) reminded PHAs that they have until close of business **April 3, 2020**, to request corrections to their CY 2020 preliminary eligibility—any requests made after this time may be subject to a delay in processing.
