HUD Publishes Quarterly Regulatory Waivers

In a *Federal Register* [notice](#) today, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) published a list of the regulatory waivers that it granted during the fourth quarter of calendar year 2019. You'll find the waivers granted by the Office of Public and Indian Housing on pages 21261–21262 of the notice (PDF pages 3–4). The PIH office granted three waivers during the quarter:

- One involved granting an exception from the requirement to compensate HUD for HUD's percentage of participation in the costs of the disposition of public housing properties
- Two granted a waiver on the requirement of the total development cost (TDC) limit of a new construction project
