HUD Awards More Than \$12 Million for Tenant Protection Vouchers

In a [press release](#) last Friday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it has awarded \$12,841,788 to seven public housing authorities to provide tenant protection vouchers (TPVs) to public housing residents. The vouchers will help households with relocation or replacement housing when their public housing units are slated under a HUD-approved plan for demolition and disposition actions or mandatory conversion. The housing assistance announced yesterday is provided through HUD's Housing Choice Voucher ([HCV](#)) program, which provides funding that assists very low-income families, the elderly, and the disabled to afford decent, safe, and sanitary housing in the private market.
