NHLP Posts Domestic Violence Newsletters

Last Friday the National Housing Law Project (NHLP) posted a series of newsletters discussing domestic violence topics. The newsletters are intended to address a variety of current housing issues that affect survivors of domestic and sexual violence.

The most recent issue of the newsletter is Issue One for 2020. It features an article outlining the tenant rights of survivors of domestic violence during the COVID-19 pandemic. The article discusses eviction moratoriums, housing protections for survivors, including the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA), asserting VAWA housing protections during the pandemic, and addressing lost income during the pandemic. This issue also includes a practice tip about the continued applicability of VAWA housing protections and a list of additional COVID-19 resources.
