HUD Issues NOFA for Studying the Impact of RAD on Children in HUD-Assisted Housing

Yesterday on [Grants.gov](https://www.grants.gov), the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) [issued](#) a notice of funding availability ([NOFA](#)) titled "Impact of RAD on Children in HUD-Assisted Households." The NOFA, which makes \$750,000 available, aims to support research projects that will advance scientific knowledge and produce policy-relevant evidence on the implementation of the RAD program and its effect on children's well-being.

The applicants should be aware of the major research goals for other RAD studies and propose a project that enhances, replicates, or complements the larger RAD evaluations or other studies, such as the one in Fresno, California. This [study](#), funded through a HUD grant, examined the effect of RAD on children's well-being in the first site to undergo a RAD conversion.
