HUD Issues NOFA for Comprehensive Housing Counseling Grants

Yesterday on [Grants.gov](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) [posted](#) the notice of funding availability (NOFA) for its [Housing Counseling Grant Program](#) for fiscal year (FY) 2020. The NOFA makes available \$3,500,000 in grants to support housing counseling organizations in assisting consumers on seeking, financing, maintaining, renting, or owning a home. The program also addresses homelessness through counseling and assists homeowners in need of foreclosure assistance.

According to the announcement, the purpose of this assistance is to continue investing in the creation and maintenance of a professional and effective housing counseling industry that is able to meaningfully assist consumers by providing them with the information they need to make informed housing choices and maximizes the impact of federal funding appropriated for HUD's Housing Counseling Program.
