HUD Releases Updated HUD-VASH Site List

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted an <u>updated state-by-state listing</u> of sites receiving funding under the HUD–Veterans Affairs (<u>VA</u>) supportive housing (<u>HUD-VASH</u>) program. The spreadsheet, which is available as a <u>PDF</u> file, shows HUD-VASH vouchers awarded since the program's inception in 2008, including the funding for fiscal year (FY) 2019.

In the HUD-VASH program, VA Medical Centers (VAMCs) assess veterans experiencing homelessness before referring them to local housing agencies for these vouchers. Since 2008, more than 100,000 vouchers have been awarded and more than 170,000 homeless veterans have been served through the program.

Rental assistance and supportive services provided through HUD-VASH are a critical resource for local communities in ending homelessness among our nation's veterans. Over the last year, the number of homeless veterans declined by two percent and has dropped by nearly 50 percent since the program was created.

HUD Updates List of IMS/PIC Errors

On March 13, 2020, HUD upgraded the Inventory Management System/PIH Information Center (IMS/PIC) to align with industry best practices for security and data integrity. According to the <u>IMS/PIC</u> <u>webpage</u>, following this upgrade, users may experience new errors when attempting to complete certain tasks in IMS/PIC. HUD is maintaining a document with a list of known issues, and how to handle them, and will update it as needed. To access the most updated document, dated May 22, 2020, click <u>here</u>.
