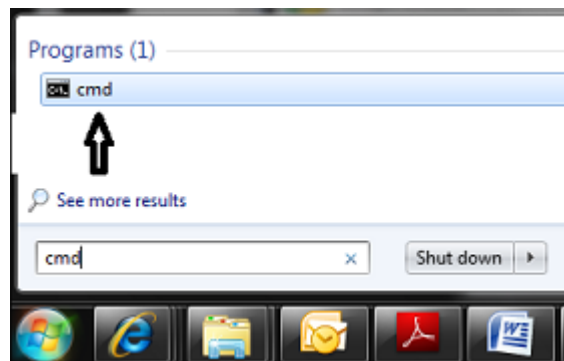


Imhostid on Windows

Windows Vista or Windows 7:

Step 1 & 2:

Go to Start menu and in the "Search Programs and Files" box type in cmd and the Command Prompt Icon should appear at the top of the list:



Step 3

At the command prompt type "*ipconfig /all*" and hit return.

This value should be sent to ffA along with your license request.

Step 4

Locate the line named "Physical Address" for the first "Ethernet Adapter" This 12 digit, hyphen separated, value is the *Imhostid*.
