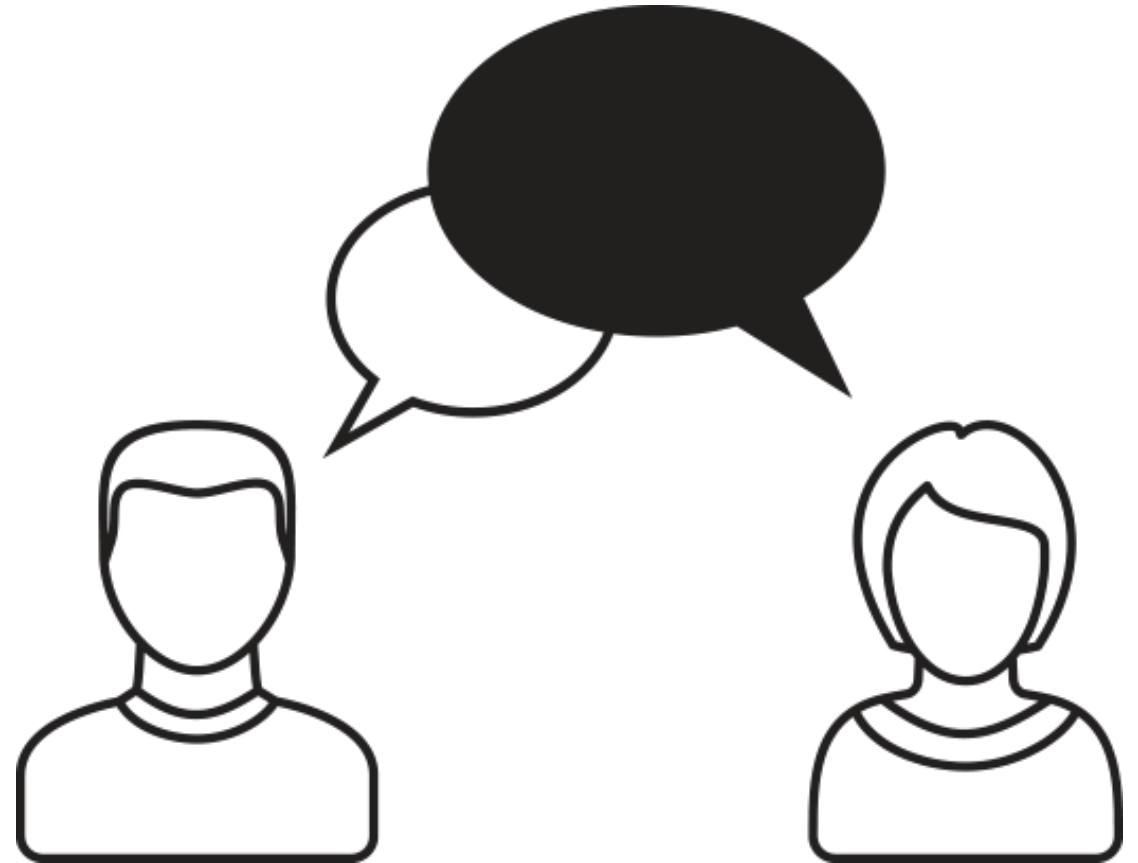

Key PPM Tool Functionality

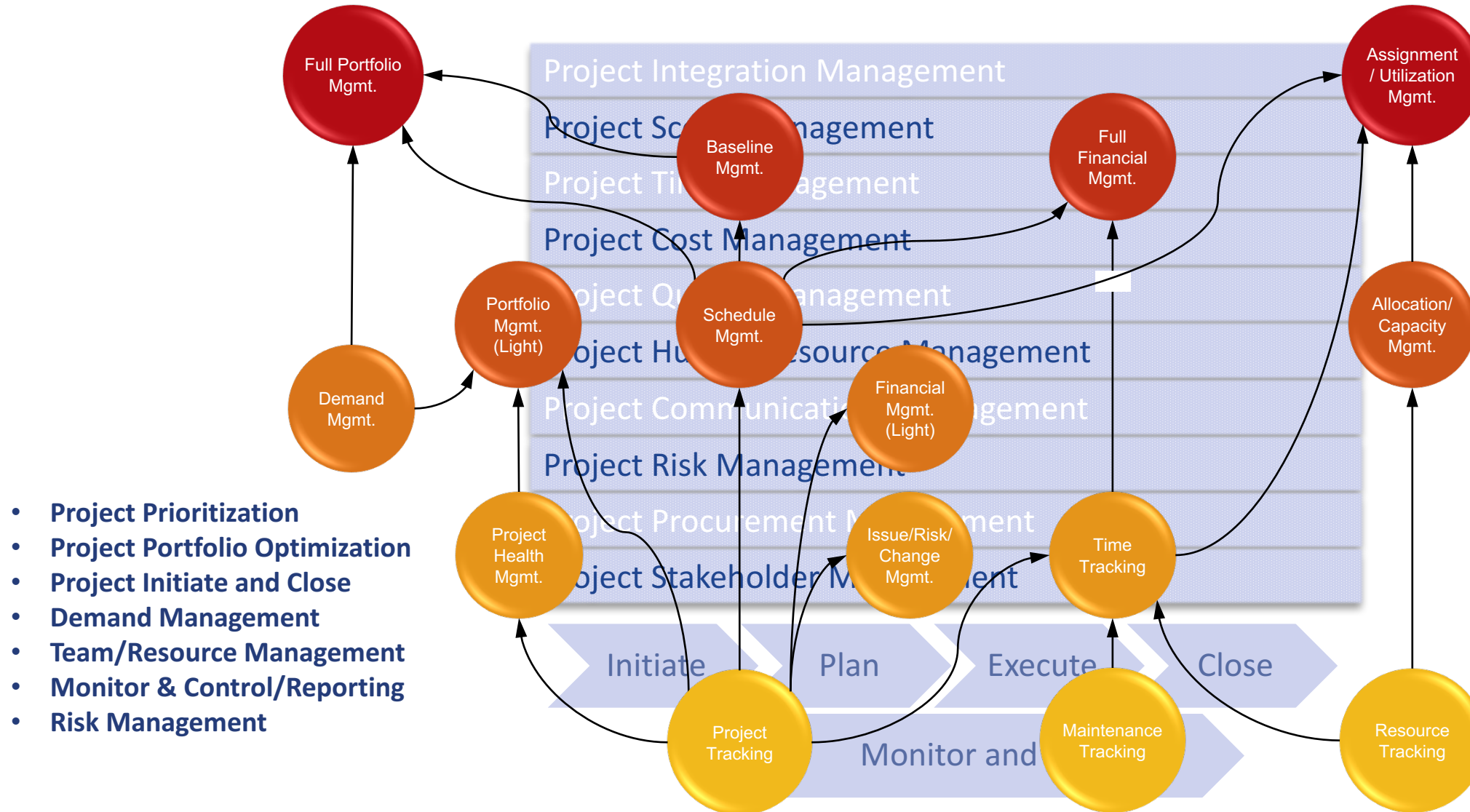

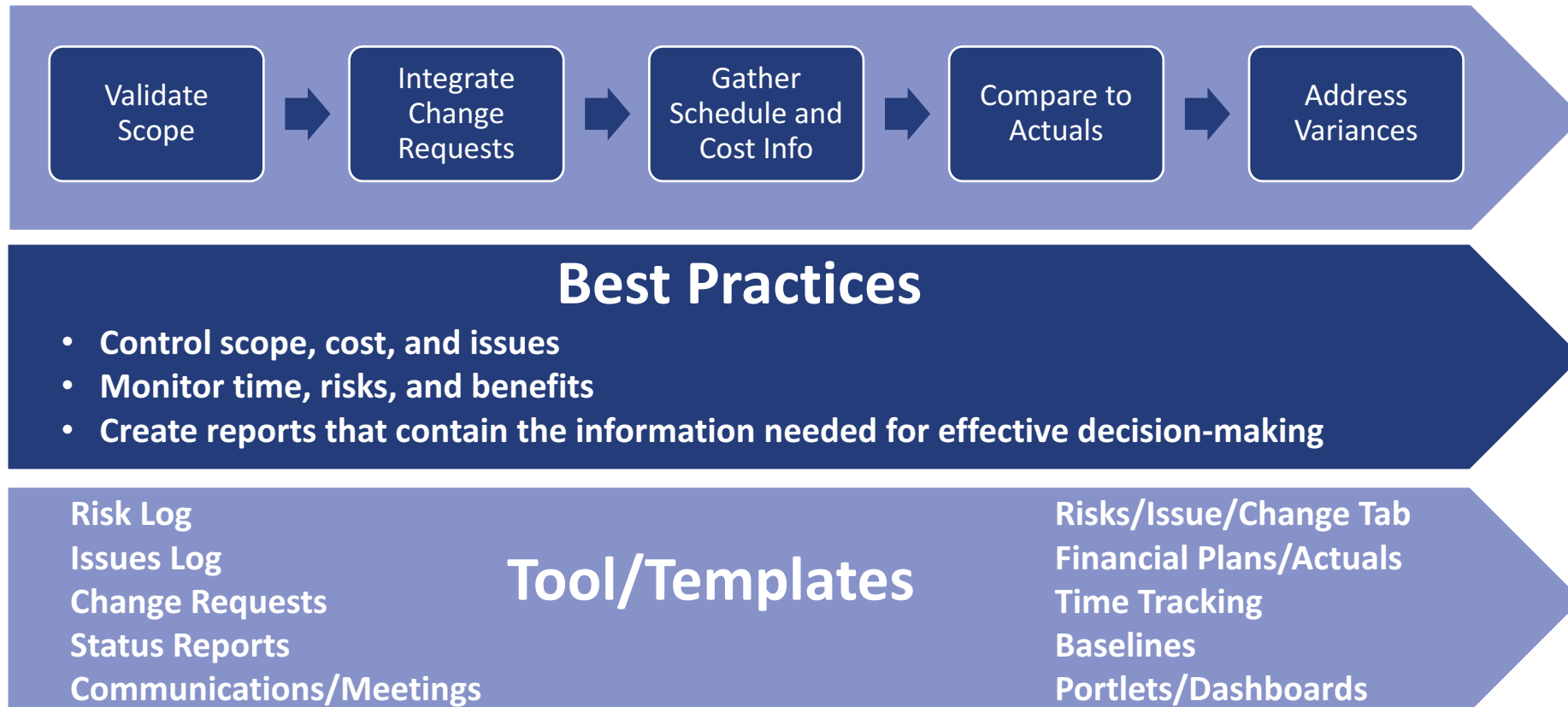

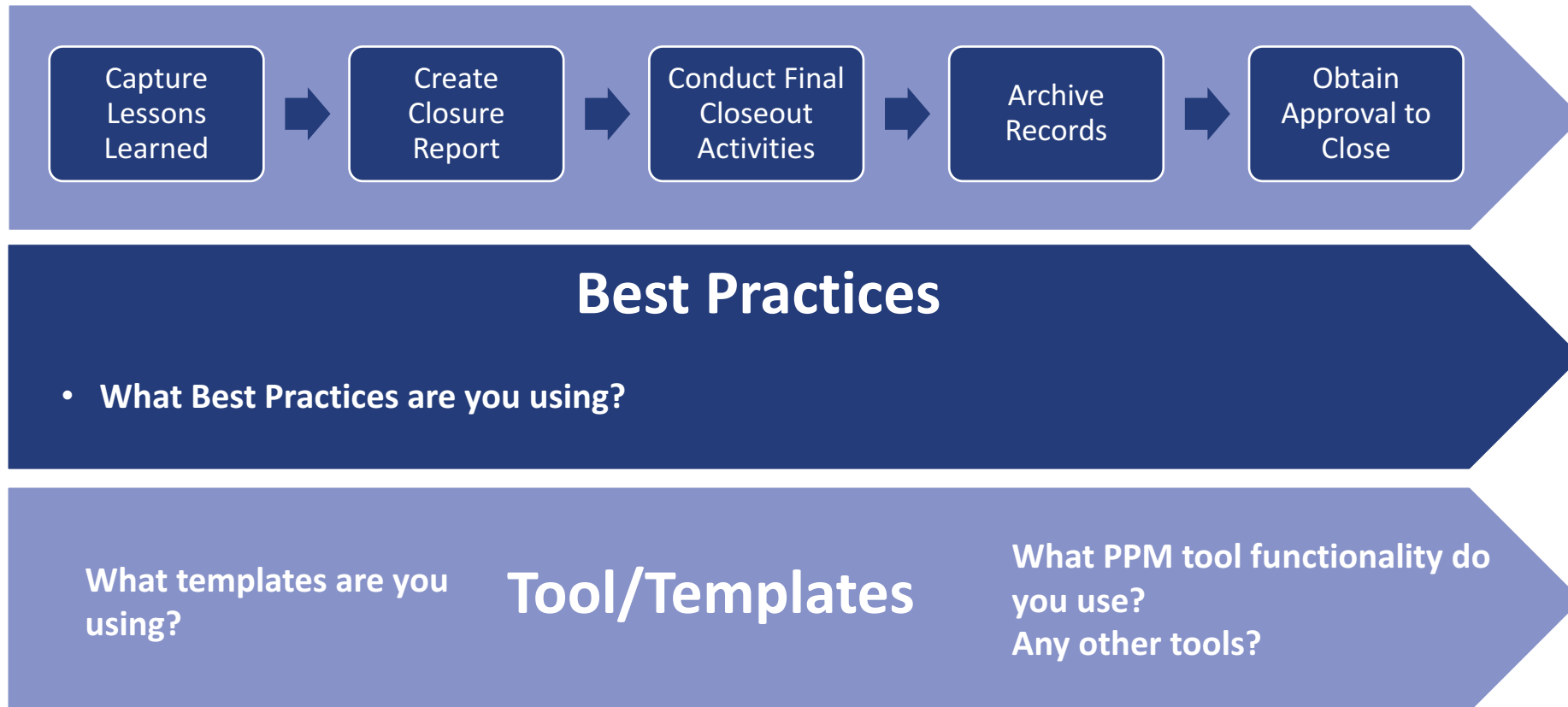

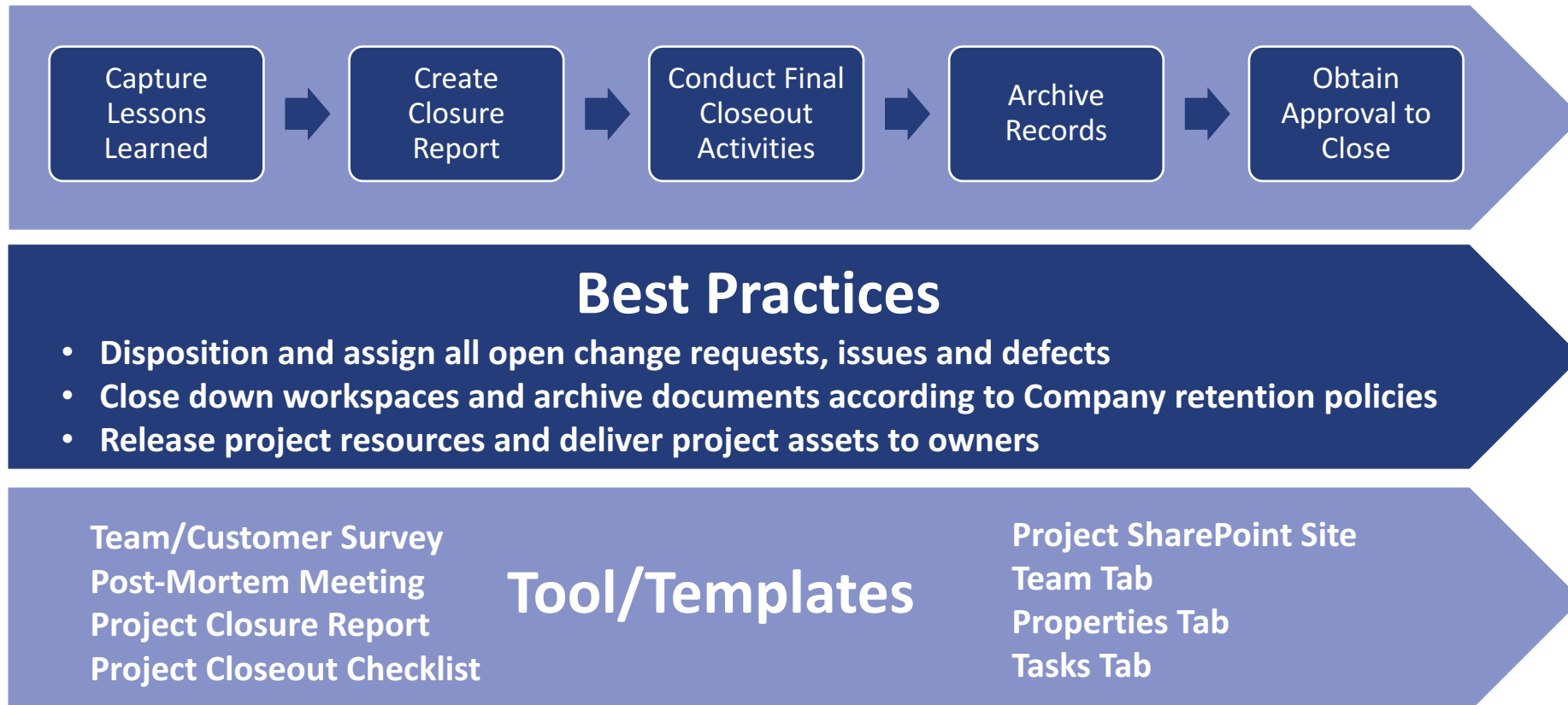

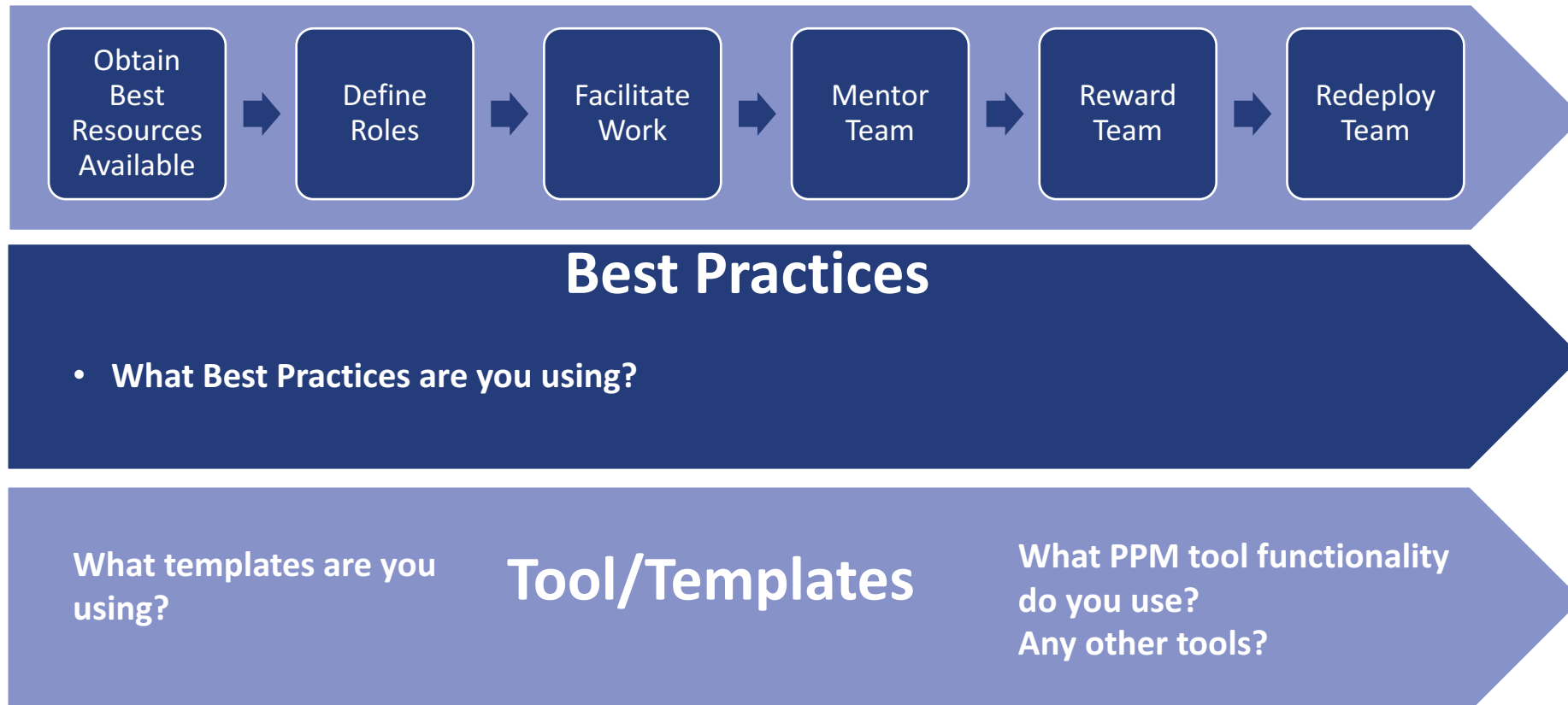
