#### Functions <u>NOT</u> Permitted by Dental Assistants in AR

The following functions are **not** permitted by any level of dental assistant:

- 20. Scaling, root planing and curettage
- 29. Final placement of orthodontic brackets 33. Placement, seating, or
- removal of any final or permanent restorations Diagnosis and treatment

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- planning Surgical or cutting
- procedures on hard or soft tissue
- Prescription, injection, inhalation, and parenteral administration of drugs (except where permitted by the Arkansas Board)
- Any procedure that contributes to or results in irreversible alteration of the oral anatomy Those functions relegated
- to a dental hygienist: 9. Using air driven electric, sonic, ultrasonic, or otherwise powered scalers or polishers (except by dental assistants possessing an expanded duties permit for polishing)
- Oral examination
- Oral prophylaxis
- Placing medicaments into the sulcus or periodontal pockets, for periodontal disease

\*Personal Supervision: The dentist is in the office or treatment facility, has personally diagnosed the condition to be treated, has personally authorized the procedures, remains in the office or treatment facility while the procedures are being performed, and evaluates the performance of the Dental Assistant before the dismissal of the patient.
