Circle K POS reports can be created in your Circle K PowerBI and used for uploading POS data to effectmanager.

Circle K POS reports for effectmanager

The file format for Circle K reports is CSV files. The reports must contain the following headers in the order given below. Sales data is on a weekly level and stored on Sundays in the POS cube.

Accepted file format: CSV

Accepted number format: 1000.00

VAT: Excluding VAT. VAT of 25% is added to the cube.

Accepted date format: YYYY, WW eg. 2020, 01

⚠ OBS! Due to an agreed rule, entries are disregarded if there are not values in both turnover and volume columns for a product.

▲ OBS! effectmanager has a limit of 20 MB for POS files when uploading.
