




WINOOSKI RIVER PARK BASIN




STRAINER STREETS

ARCHITECTURE


new developments offer alternative living typologies – young and old get the opportununity to live in new communal high performance buildings that are constructed from locally sourced, sustainable materials

a new hybrid of a parking garage and a public park with exterior surfaces that allow for a variety of playful outdoor activities during all seasons







MAKER SPACE LIVING

a new hybrid of residential units and shared work space with a highly flexible construction that enables the building to adapt to market demands providing **excellent opportunities for younger generations**





INDOOR FARMERS MARKET

dedicated to connecting farmers, food producers, and chefs that support Vermont agriculture, and bring fresh, flavorful, high-quality food to all Vermonters and guests – **bridging generations**, the program includes elderly housing and daycare




COMMUNAL GARDENS


