Your daily responsibilities will include:

- Understanding and applying the Greenhouse Gas Emissions Protocol standard when analysing company reporting

- Reporting problems with the data to the Senior CDA and Head of Analytics
- Reaching out to companies via email / phone to retrieve missing data
- First and second line support to CDA interns during data collection
- Second and third round data checks and data verification (Quality Assurance)
- Data cleaning and outlier checks with the Head of Analytics
- Supporting people and performance management by reporting on CDA submission quality to senior management
- Training coordination support (scheduling, calendar management)
