- > Why do you think these are called "deadly sins?" What makes them so harmful?
- Let's recap: The 7 Deadly Sins are Pride, Envy, Anger, Sloth, Avarice (Greed), Gluttony and Lust. Which one do you think is the biggest struggle for our culture?
- Often people find that they are afflicted by one deadly sin more than the others. Traditionally this is called the "primary sin." Think about which of the deadly sins is the most challenging for you.
