Baptism	1. is a sacrament and a sacrifice.
Confirmation	2. is the sacrament through which men receive the power and grace to perform the sacred duties of bishops, priests, and other ministers of the Church.

Reconciliation	4. is the sacrament that gives our souls the new life of Sanctifying Grace, by which we become children of God and heirs of heaven.

Matrimony	7. is the sacrament which, through the anointing with blessed oil by the priest, and through his prayer, gives health and strength to the soul and sometimes to the body when we are in danger of death from sickness, accident, or old age.
