The Government of Antigua and Barbuda has decided that it would like to make it simpler for people in the country to interact with the government and to improve the ease of doing business. To do this, they have chosen to work with De La Rue and a local IT company (ACT) to transform the Civil Registration and Vital Statistics system. This will provide people with a trusted legal identity from birth.

Midwives will be able to notify the government that a birth has taken place on mobile technology and the birth will be verified and registered centrally. With their legal identity, people will be able to access key services, pay taxes and set-up businesses more easily. De La Rue and local firm ACT have based the solution on local laws and are proud to be able to build and deploy replicable models in the region and globally, bolstering Antiguan skills and industry.
