

Section A

Receiving Shipper

Step A1



Once the dewar has arrived, remove old shipping pouch and zip-tie.

Step A2



Unlock latch by turning the key to the left.

The latch will “unhook,” from the top of the dewar.



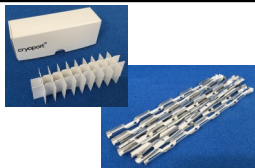
Open the lid to expose the dewar.

Section B

Packing the Specimen

IMPORTANT NOTE: Commodity and accessories must be pre-conditioned prior to loading into the sample chamber. A 20% reduction of holding time can occur if the materials are not preconditioned prior to loading into the shipper.

Load samples to



Plastic 65mm Goblet
2 can be loaded into a Canister with a Lifter. 7 Canisters can be loaded into the dewar.

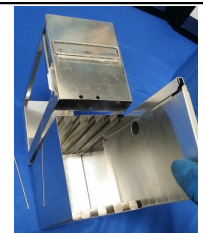
Canes Can hold 5 (2ml) vials.

CryoVial Box Can hold 30 (2ml) vials



Safepak™ Can hold 15 canes or 2 (5 1/2" x 2" x 2") boxes. 7 bags can be loaded into the dewar.

CryoVial Box Rack
Can hold 5 (5 3/8" x 5 3/8" x 2 1/4") or 10 (5 1/2" x 2" x 2") boxes.



Cassette Rack
Can hold 9 (9.5" x 6" x 0.5") cassettes.

Section C

Loading Samples for Shipment

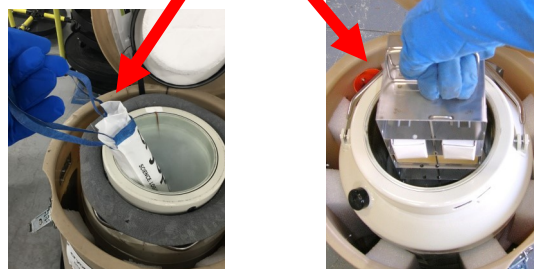
Step C1

Once the specimen is packaged, remove the lid and rest it sideways behind the dewar and against the brown top.



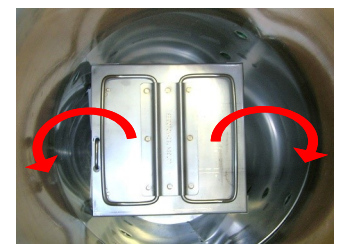
Step C2

Lower the packaged commodity into the dewar with gloved hands.



Step C3

If your commodity is loaded in a rack, ensure the handles are lying flat against the top.

Section D

Packaging the Shipment

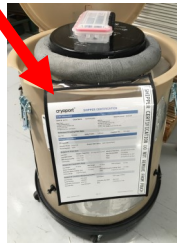
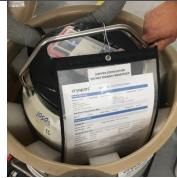
Step D1

Replace the shipper plug.



Step D2

Remove the Leg 2 shipping pouch from document protector attached to the dewar handle inside of the container.



Step D3

Remove any classification labels from the shipping pouch and place on the metal diamond.

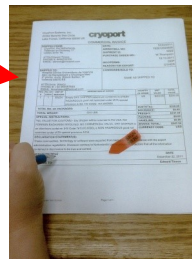


Step D4

International Shipments ONLY

Remove the Commercial Invoices located in the shipping pouch.

1. Sign and Date.
2. Return all documents being shipped behind the Air Waybill. Including any: Permits, Forms, Licenses, etc.



Step D5

Once all documents are loaded:

1. Close the shipping pouch and remove sticker backing.
2. Place shipping pouch on metal plate.
3. Close lid.



Step D6



Lock latch by turning the key to the right.

Step D7

Always secure Latches with Zip Ties prior to shipment

For those shipments containing regulated dangerous goods/hazardous materials, the shipper is responsible for correctly preparing the shipment according to the current International Air Transport Association (IATA) and International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) dangerous goods regulations. This includes correct identification, classification, packaging, dangerous goods markings and labeling as well as completion of all pertinent and required documentation. The shipper is the customer who is preparing the shipment at each leg in the transportation of the dry dewar packaging.
