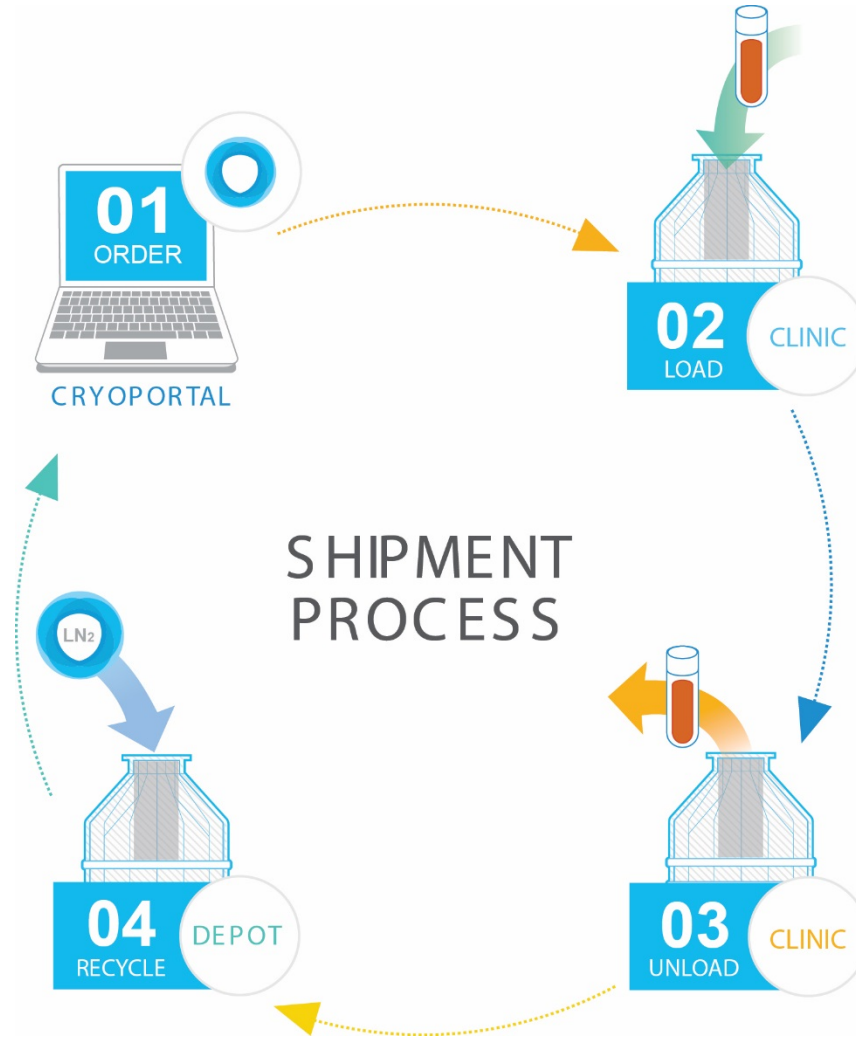

Domestic Shipping

- Domestic shipping is easier than international shipping
 - Faster shipping times
 - Fewer regulations
- Paperwork is straightforward
 - Easy to get
 - Easy to understand
- Most domestic shipments are completed within the working week



International Shipping

- International shipping is more complex
- Important to select a reliable company
- Understand exactly what services are provided
 - Get it in writing
- The best option is to choose a company who will
 - Clear customs
 - Provide clinic-door to clinic-door transportation

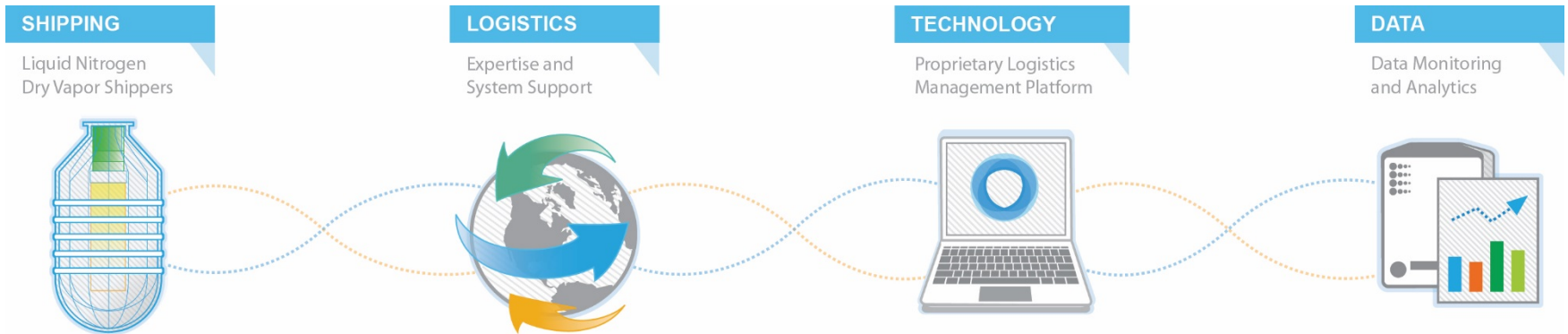


International Clinics

- Documentation is key when shipping internationally
 - Requirements change often
 - Cryoport reviews current customs requirements before shipment
- Make sure the international clinic has an Import/Export Certificate (IEC)
 - Authorization from their government to send or received shipment
- A commercial invoice is always needed
- Ideally your shipping company can help you navigate customs and documentation
 - Make sure they have a customer service team available 24/7 to ensure shipments are delivered safely
