- Re-stocking and inventory control

- Cost incurred when tool arrives from sterile processing with cement still clinging to it

And MOST IMPORTANT

Remember that even a micro scratch on an implant caused by a metal instrument can compromise the long-term success of the procedure. The cost of a single revision dwarfs the cost of a single-use curette.
