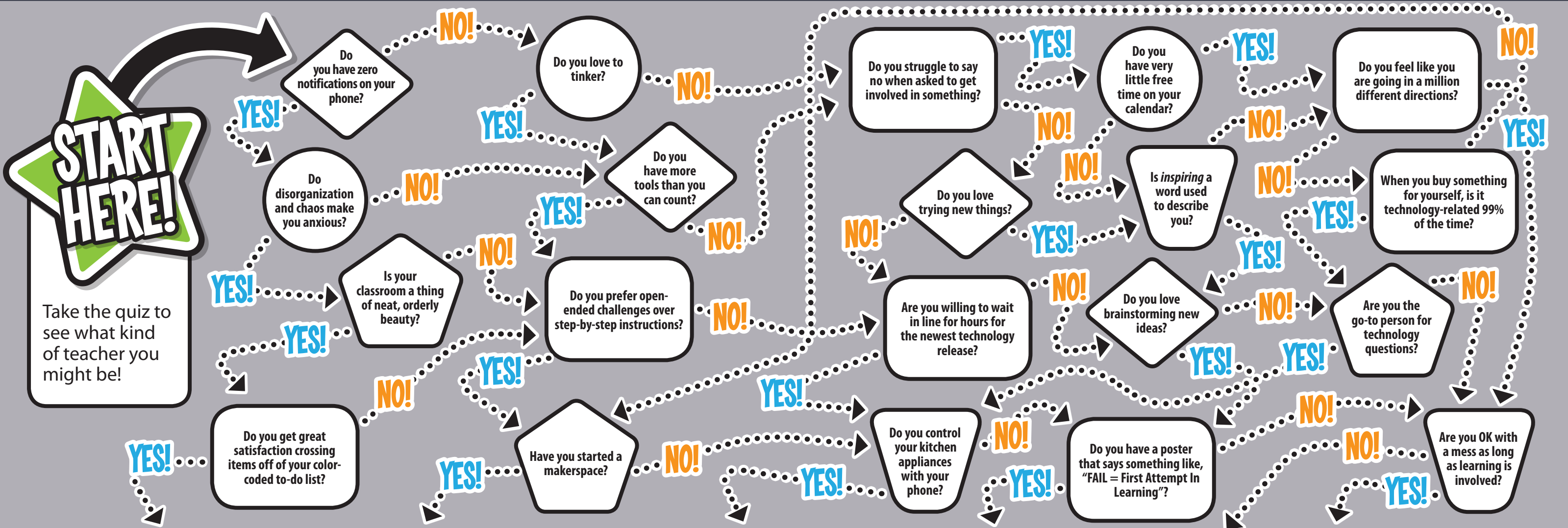


WHAT'S YOUR TEACHING TYPE?

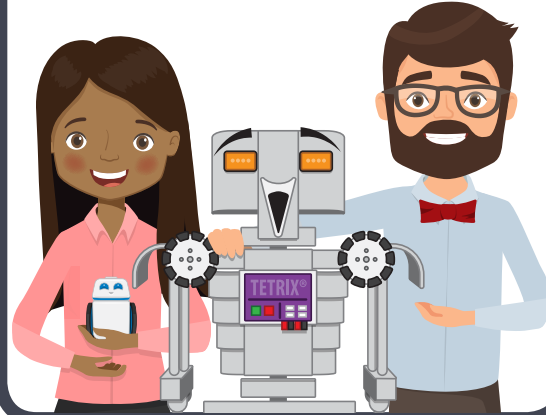
MERRY MAKER
