### Fun facts for March:

- St. Patrick was not Irish. He was actually born in Scotland or Wales and took the name Patricus when he became a priest.
- Mardi Gras colors of purple, green and gold represent Justice (purple), Faith (green), and Power (gold).
- Mardi Gras Masks were first worn so that people of different social classes could intermingle during the festivities.
- The word Lent doesn't appear in the Bible in association with the 40 days leading up to Easter. It's derived from an old English word meaning "lengthen", and was chosen because Easter falls during springtime, when the days start to lengthen.
