Implement facility cleaning protocols to eliminate pathogens through intensive disinfectant procedures, minimizing risk of exposure and transmission.

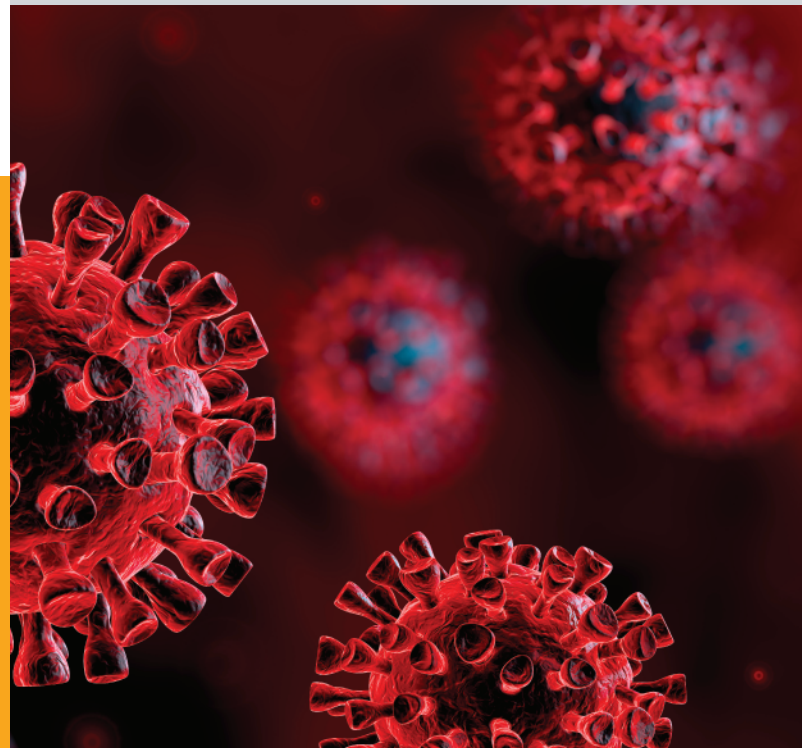

- Mobilize - Phase and Coordinate the Work
- Track the Progress and Costs on a Shift-by-Shift Basis
- Oversee and Enforce Safety Precautions Re: Worker Exposure
- Conduct Final Assessment and Testing /Verification
