



The EPEC Process

- 1. You are selected for the program and receive your EPEC kit.
- 2. Complete the Introductory Module and explore your *EPEC resources.
- 3. Begin the 1st module.
- 4. Finish your module and submit your workbook to NAED via Dropbox. NOTE: Would you like to provide feedback or suggestions for the module? We'd appreciate it if you'd submit the Module Evaluation Survey. (Click here for location of the survey.)
- 5. Start training in the next EPEC Module.
- 6. Your received workbook is assigned to an EPEC reviewer.
- 7. The reviewer evaluates the workbook and sends the results to NAED. **NOTE:** In 'My Transcript' your module status will now show "Completed" or "Incomplete."
- 8. If your workbook is marked Completed: nothing more is needed for this module.
- 9. If your workbook is marked Incomplete: review the comments, rework, and resubmit. *NOTE:* Check your next module to make sure you didn't make the same mistakes.
- 10. Once all modules have been reviewed and marked completed launch the Final Exam!
- 11. Once you have passed the exam, please complete the Course Evaluation Survey. **NOTE:** Please be honest and detailed with your feedback. We use these to update future editions.
- 12. After you have passed your final & finished the survey, you will need to complete your Capstone Project and submit to NAED via Dropbox.
- 13. As soon as your Capstone is reviewed as Completed, you are officially a graduate of the level!

EPEC Introductory Module

EPEC Online Module & Workbook Guide (cont.)

Below is a walkthrough on the how-to's of retrieving and submitting your EPEC Workbooks, as well as our expectations for receipt of your submittal. Please make sure to submit appropriately.

Workbook Submittal Guide

- 1. Download the EPEC Workbook. (Click here for more information on location of the EPEC Workbooks.)
- 2. Open up the saved EPEC Workbook on your computer.* Each workbook is an editable PDF.

NOTE: Make sure you are in Adobe before filling out. Do not fill out workbook online as it will not save.

- 3. Fill out the PDF by clicking on and typing within each blue highlighted box.
- 4. Areas the student does NOT touch:
 - a. Page 3 EPEC Reviewers Comments
 - b. Reviewer Comments checkboxes
 - c. Reviewer Comments box below questions
- 5. Answer ALL questions and attach any cut sheets requested to the workbook itself.
- 6. After completing the workbook and attaching cut sheets, **SAVE** the PDF.

NOTE: We prefer cut sheets to be attached within the PDF itself, however we know not all students have this ability. If you are unable to insert your cuts within the workbook itself, rename each cut sheet with the product being submitted. (Example: Enclosure.pdf) Then, please provide all cuts & workbook within a zip file.

If you need assistance zipping a file, view the Submission Tutorial Video or Intro Module 'Packaging Files to Send' for specific instructions.

 Click on the EPEC Submittal link on the last page of the workbook and a link to Dropbox will open.

8. Click on **Choose files.**

- 9. Select the SAVED workbook (or zipped workbook & cuts) for upload.
- 10. Type your first name, last name, and email address. Click Upload.
- 11. A verification submittal email will be sent to NAED and you.
- 12. Your workbook will be assigned to a reviewer.
- 13. Once the workbook has been reviewed, it will be marked complete or incomplete and your transcript will be updated with your workbook status.
- 14. You will receive an email with your status and a copy of the reviewed module.
 - a. If your module is marked Incomplete: review the reviewer's comments, rework, and resubmit.



The final exam consists of multiple choice, true-false, and matching questions. You must score a 75% or higher to pass. Your score will be automatically recorded on your transcript.

Once you pass, the exam will be marked Completed and you have finished the content portion of this EPEC curriculum. You may now move onto your Evaluation Survey & Capstone Project.

Should you fail the exam, no worries. Simply relaunch, select "Cancel" when offered to continue where you left off, and then retake the exam and submit. There isn't a limit to exam attempts.

- 6. Once your Capstone has been marked completed, you have graduated this level!





- b) To view your community subscriptions, click the 'Communities' option from the drop-down menu next to the Live Chat link in the top right-hand corner.



Each level and module of the EPEC program has a separate "community" to make it easier to quickly get exactly the information you are looking for. Select the level you would like to view discussions on or post a question for.

6. Once you find the level and/or module that you wish to explore, click the DISCUSSION tab to view the available questions/threads in that section.





Subscribing to Forum Discussions:

7. If you'd like to post a question or be notified of any questions asked & answered, from the landing page click "Join Community" on the right. You must "Join Community" for each community you wish to post on or be notified of.



NOTE: Subscribing is not necessary if you only want to view the existing questions. However, should you wish to be updated on new questions posted or to post a new question to the community, you will need to subscribe.





EPEC Forum Walkthrough (cont.)

8. When you click "Join Community" a box will pop up asking you for your notification preferences. You may select how often you'd like to be notified via email when activity occurs within that community. **NOTE:** I recommend choosing at least 'Daily Digest.' If you 'opt-out' of email messages, you will not be notified when your question has been answered.

Posting to Forum Discussions:

9. If you don't see the answer to your question already posted, you may post a new question. Before you will be able to post to the desired community, you must first have subscribed to the community. To post a new question, simply click "Post New Message" to launch a window allowing you to submit your new question.


EPEC resources are now located within the new EPEC Forum on NAED Connect.

How-To Change Your Password
