- Early Registration Discount does not apply to payments made after January 5, 2018.
- Payments made after January 12, 2018 are subject to pay the Late Registration Fee of Kshs. 2,000.
- Students paying in installments are required to pay an additional Kshs. 1,500, This amount divided into two payments with Kshs.1,000 added onto Payment 2 and Kshs. 500 added onto Payment 3.

DIPLOMA TUITION COSTS INCLUDE:



Global Professional Standard Certificate: Students develop the professional skills they need to compete in today's global workplace through our year-long Career Launchpad programme.



Industry Exposure: Students build their industry knowledge and professional networks by attending conferences, workshops, festivals, and mentorship talks.

PAYMENT & REFUND POLICIES

Payment Required to Enroll: Once you are accepted at ADMI, your place will only be confirmed after you pay 50% of the term fees and the required insurance. All programmes are capped at 24 students. Accepted students are encouraged to enroll as early as possible to secure a place in their desired programmes.

Late Fee Payments: A late payment fee of Kshs. 2,000 applies to all payments made after January 12, 2018. This also applies for payments that haven't met the 50% threshold. The last day for late registration is January 22, 2018. Students will not be admitted after January 22, 2018.

Refunds: All payments are non-refundable and non-transferable to other programmes. ADMI will only refund students if a programme is cancelled, and students and sponsors will be notified of any cancellations by January 5, 2018. ADMI reserves the right to cancel a programme for operational reasons.



Late Payments: Students will not be allowed to attend classes until payment has been made. Non-attendance negatively impacts academic performance. Students who miss 3 or more classes will be required to retake the unit. Therefore, ADMI strongly encourages students and their families to make the payments on time.

Outstanding Balances: If a student completes a term with an outstanding fee balance, he/she cannot enroll in another term until that outstanding balance has been paid.

Deferring a Term: ADMI encourages students to defer to the next term if they and their families are not confident they are able to pay the required fees by the above deadlines.

Enrolling in Additional Units: If a student wishes to pursue an interest outside his/her programme, he/she can enroll in an additional unit. Students are required to inform the administration in writing by January 5, 2018 and pay an additional Kshs. 20,000 per additional unit by January 12, 2018.

Enrolling in Private Tutoring: If a student is struggling in a unit and requires additional one-on-one support, he/she can enroll in private tutoring. The student is required to inform the administration in writing and receive written approval from the administration. The price for tutoring is an additional Kshs. 1,500 per hour and payment for private tutoring is required upfront.

Resit Policy & Payments: If a student is unable to sit for final exams due to special circumstances, he/she must inform the administration in writing before April 1, 2018. The student is required to pay a resit fee of Kshs. 5,000 per exam. Resit payment for January - April term must be made before May 15, 2018 and resits must be completed by May 30, 2018.

Retake Policy and Payments: As a premier institution, ADMI upholds high academic standards. If a student fails a unit, he/she must seek permission to retake a unit. The administration reserves the right to approve or decline requests on a case by case basis. If approval is granted, the student must pay Kshs. 25,000 for retaking a unit. It should be noted that if a student fails more than 1 unit, the administration reserves the right to dismiss the student from continuing his/her studies at ADMI.

Fee Increase: Please be aware that schools fees are liable to increase between 10 and 20% every January to account for inflation and other considerations.

Due to the 2017 election, the Board has postponed the fee increase to the May 2018 term.

Parents and students should plan for fees to increase by 8% for new students and 3.5% for continuing students. This increase will apply to all programmes for the May 2018 term.

Overpayment: Any fee overpayment will be automatically transferred to next term's fees. ADMI will not process any refunds.



Graduation: Students are not allowed to graduate if they have not completed and passed all of the required units for their programme.

SCHOOL-BASED ACCIDENT EMERGENCY INSURANCE 🛨



Overview: The school-based emergency insurance is mandatory for all students, even if the student is covered by another insurance provider. Insurance is provided by AAR Insurance, and covers immediate medical attention on campus. The cover includes the following: ground and air ambulance, on-site treatment and stabilization, transfer to hospital, and outpatient care with an annual limit of Kshs. 100,000. This insurance is only for school-based emergencies. Sponsors are required to respond and arrive to the school or hospital immediately to collect the student.

Continuing Students: Students enrolled in four-term diploma programmes are required to pay an additional Kshs. 1,500 in their fourth term. Students enrolled in a diploma programme requiring five terms are required to pay an additional Kshs. 2,500. This means that the total amount for school-based emergency insurance is Kshs. 4,000 for a four term diploma programme and Kshs. 5,000 for a five-term diploma programme.
