

Submit a drawing of the superheroine you imagine for this animation. Make sure the image tells Disney and the world a little bit about Kenyan culture.

Film & TV Diploma Applicants: In 1 paragraph tell us about the movie or TV series that inspired you to want to study film and TV production. Using your phone or camera, shoot a 1-minute opening scene of the movie you want to make while you are studying at ADMI. Share a link of the opening scene here ______ or submit your opening scene on a DVD. Please test the link or DVD before submitting your application.

Then listen to the theme song in an outdoor environment and then in a small indoor space and answer the following two questions:

Journalism & Multimedia: Pick a person you admire and write a 1-page blog about this person. Add elements of multimedia (e.g. a photograph or video) to enhance the story.

English-Language Proficiency: The language of instruction at ADMI is English. As a result, candidates whose first language is not English or who did not go to an education system with English as the language of instruction will be required to demonstrate adequate English language proficiency.

Admission: ADMI reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to any individual. Former applicants or students who have lost good standing may be denied re-entry, or may have conditions placed on readmission.

Number of Accepted Students per Intake: All programmes are capped at 24 students.

Payment: Once a student has been accepted into a programme, his/her place is only confirmed after a minimum payment (50% of the first term's fees and required medical insurance) has been made. This initial payment must be made by January 12, 2018. Payments made after this date will not be accepted, and students will not be able to enroll for the January 2018 intake.

Programme Cancellation: ADMI reserves the right to cancel a programme for operational reasons. When ADMI cancels a programme, all fees (including the application fee) will be refunded. ADMI will notify students and parents of any cancellations by January 5, 2018.

Time Commitment: All students should be aware that classes can be scheduled on Monday to Fridays from 8:30am to 8:30pm as well as Saturdays form 8:30am to 4:00pm. The class timetable will be given at the start of each term, and it is the student's responsibility to attend all classes. Class timings will not be moved to accommodate students' other commitments.
