



How do you match the design of a facility to the individualized care offered there? Invacare Interior Design gathered inspiration from the scenery in beautiful Lutz, Florida to not only make residents feel at home, but also to help individualize and differentiate the neighborhood-style living found at Tampa Lakes Health and Rehabilitation.





“From the flooring to the finishing touches, Invacare Interior Design was there every step of the way,” said Joshua Byers, Special Projects and Purchasing Director at Summit Care II, Inc.

With six similarly architected neighborhoods, each featuring its own dining area, living room, and activity space, it was a priority to make the facility easy to navigate for both residents and guests.

For lead interior designer on the Tampa Lakes project, Sasha Ellis-Grailer, differentiating the buildings by color not only created an opportunity to individualize the design to match the care provided at the facility, but also was a way to bring more of the bright, Floridian colors and patterns inside the building and use them as a tool for wayfinding.





“Everything from the signage to the furniture in each neighborhood followed a distinct color scheme,” said Ellis-Grailer. “The use of color helped provide a sense of direction throughout the neighborhoods.”

Byers said that the facility stands above everything they have done, and everyone has mentioned that.

“It’s a great example of the value and importance of interior design and what it can do for the development of the overall facility,” said Byers.
