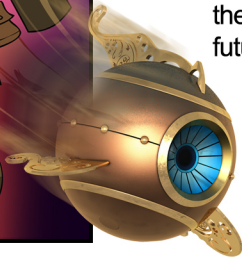




## Physical Science with Justin Time

Buckle up, time traveler, the past and the future are yours.



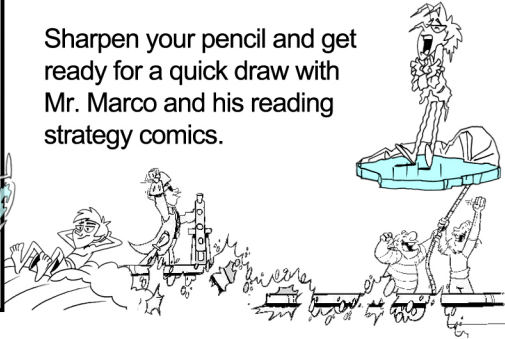

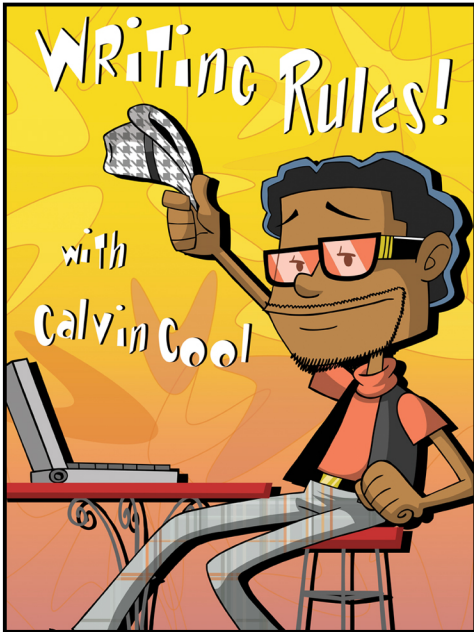
