Reversing the Summer Slide, Istation Helps

Students Achieve Big Gains in Reading

How Blended Learning Prevents Summer Learning Loss and Supports Powerful Growth

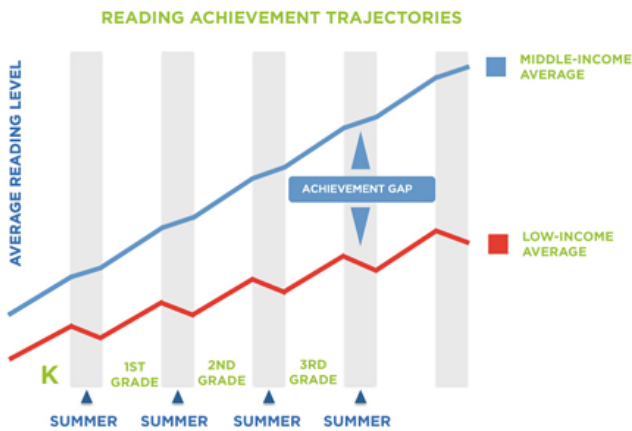
Nationally, low-income students experience an average of more than two months' worth of learning loss in reading achievement every summer. But when Tackle Summer Slide, an initiative designed to combat summer reading loss, implemented Istation's interactive curriculum for struggling readers, students' scores soared.

Learning, Tackle Tomorrow, and Istation, the initiative proved successful as data showed significant support and growth for students using Istation.

Reversing the summer slide trend

Using diagnostic reports from students who participated in Tackle Summer Slide, research shows that 72% of students in the summer program did not experience summer learning loss, compared to the previous year's 64%.

Additionally, 69% of participating students stayed on grade level or had significant growth compared to the previous year's 57%. Of the participating students, 53% gained at least two months' reading ability, reversing the summer slide trend.
