

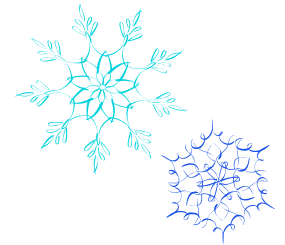
Holiday Home Safety Tips



- *Carefully inspect new and previously used holiday lights before plugging in.*
- *Discard damaged electrical decorations and lights.*
- *Do not overload electrical outlets or extension cords.*
- *Be careful not to damage light strings or extension cords when decorating.*
- *Keep children and pets away from light strings and electrical decorations.*



- *Place Christmas tree safely away from portable heaters, radiators or fireplaces.*
- *Place tree out of walkways and do not block doorways.*
- *Be sure the base is steady and secure to avoid tipping over.*
- *Keep trees watered. A dried out tree is a fire hazard.*
- *Turn off lights when away from home or while sleeping.*



- *Place candles in a safe, secure place before lighting.*
- *Do not leave lit candles unattended while away from home or sleeping.*
- *Keep lit candles away from Christmas trees or other flammable decorations.*
- *Never use candles to decorate a Christmas tree.*



- *Unattended cooking is the leading cause of home fires in the U.S.*
- *Always stay in the kitchen while cooking on the stove top—especially when frying.*
- *Make sure you have a working fire extinguisher in/near the kitchen.*
- *Watch children while in the kitchen and warn of potential burn hazards.*
