INSTALLATION INFORMATION SHEET

The information below will help to ensure a smooth installation.

<u>ACCESS</u>: Our installers will need a clear pathway from the entry to the installation location in your home. Please notify us of any gate/alarm codes, key locations or any other special instructions for how to access your home on the day of installation.

CARE OF HOME: We take great pride in our work as well as the condition of your home during our installation. Our installers utilize furniture blankets, shoe covers and plastic mats to protect your floors. We will do everything we can to protect your home, but nicks and scratches could happen during the normal course of installation. For safety purposes, our installers **cannot** remove their shoes during installation.

CHILDREN & PETS: Please keep them clear of the work area for the duration of the installation.

<u>CLEAN UP:</u> Upon completion, our installers will wipe down your new Valet product as well as clean up any dust or debris resulting from the installation.

PAINT: A fresh coat of paint is always a good idea, but please be sure to have all painting done at least 48 hours prior to our installation.

TEAR OUT: If Valet is tearing out your existing structure (as listed on your proposal) then we will haul away the debris with the exception of wire shelves and metal cabinets.

Product Specific Preparation

CABINETRY & GARAGES: Please allow an 8 ft. clearance in the area of the installation.

CLOSETS: Closet must be emptied of all contents prior to installation. Please allow at least 6 feet of clearance in front of the closet.

EPOXY: The garage floor must be clear of all contents including large appliances. Sinks and water heaters may remain in place. The floor must be completely dry prior to the installation.
