## TV & Movies

The following streaming services are currently offering extended free trials:

- CBS All Access - 30 day free trial when you use the promo code "ALL"
- Roku Channel – 30 day free trial of select channels
- SHOWTIME – 30 day free trial
- SlingTV – Watch free, no sign-up required
- VUDU - offers free movies to stream, although most will play with ads.
- HBO Now App – Handful of classic HBO shows (like The Sopranos, True Blood and the WIRE) are free, no subscription required.

## Music

- Amazon Music Unlimited – 3 month free trial
- SiriusXM - offering free unlimited listening of their wide variety of stations – no sign-up required
- Spotify and Pandora have free listening options with ads and limited skips.

## Libraries

Libraries have digital content available to check out including eBooks, audiobooks, magazines, comic books, movies, music, and more. If you don't already have a library card, many libraries are now allowing you to sign up for a temporary card online.

For eBooks, you can also sign up for a 3 month trial of Amazon Kindle Unlimited.
