### Virtual Tours

- <u>Google Arts & Culture</u> take virtual tours and view online exhibits from museums around the world

- <u>National Theatre</u> will be posting a stage show from its archives every Thursday.

#### Zoos & Aquarium

- Many zoos have live web cams set up in their animal habitats including <u>San Diego Zoo</u>, <u>Houston</u> <u>Zoo</u>, <u>Maryland Zoo</u>, <u>Smithsonian National Zoo</u>, and <u>Atlanta Zoo</u>.
- <u>The Cincinatti Zoo & Botanical Garden</u> is featuring a live "Home Safari" every day on their Facebook page where they highlight one of the animals from their zoo.
- Several aquariums also have live webcams including the <u>Monterey Bay Aquarium</u> or the <u>National</u> <u>Aquarium</u> in Baltimore.
