

#small B | Gidea-7 Pedagogy Explained



When a child opens a book, it is the beginning of a magical journey into learning. Let it begin on the right foot, with the child as a co-creator of his learning journey. An entry that begins with a pedagogically sound question and sets the stage for learning the subject throughout the year.

What can you do:

- 1. Remove the brown covers on the textbook and cover it with a plain white paper
- 2. Give the child a pedagogy-based question to write on the new white cover
- 3. Let them draw, write or express their answer to the question on the white cover in their own unique way

Pedagogic "Why" for the #SmallBlGidea:

The questions for the cover page are essentially designed based on the theory of Constructivism. Key benefits of this idea are:

- 1. Helps the child recollect his/her pre-knowledge on the subject from previous Grades.
- 2. Learning experience is enhanced when the child co-creates it with the teacher.
- 3. Brings a sense of ownership and relevance with the core subject itself.
