

#### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION - YOUTH LEADERS AND CHAPERONES:**

<u>FEES:</u> \$160.00 per participant (\$175 after January 15th) for each participant and chaperone. This is the best deal in town, when you consider the accommodation, excellent meals and activities. This is a wonderful place for youth to renew friendships, form new ones and spend time building their relationship with GOD!

YOUTH REGISTRATION FORMS: Send or bring ONE cheque — Payable to St. Patrick's Church, to cover the fees for your participants. Each youth <u>must</u> review the <u>Code of Conduct & Dress Code and complete a Registration and Parental Permission Form.</u> Please send these Registration and Parental Permission forms to Bonni at <u>broset@telus.net</u> on or before <u>January 15, 2020</u>. We require this information for room assignments and meal planning. The kitchen at Homewood also requires the list of allergy considerations two weeks prior to the retreat. Feel free to send your Parish cheque covering your groups' fees to this address as well (cheques must be payable to St. Patrick's Church).

<u>CHAPERONES</u>: Please send one chaperone for every 8 students. As well, please provide both male and female chaperones as needed by your group. CLERGY, YOUTH LEADERS AND CHAPERONES ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A <u>SIGNED</u> COVENANT OF CARE AND CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK ON FILE IN THEIR PARISHES.

ROOM ASSIGNMENTS: We will try our best to accommodate requests. However, we must remind everyone that we are limited in our sleeping arrangements when our camp is full. Decisions about room assignments are prayerfully made with the help of Camp Homewood Staff. PLEASE DO NOT MAKE ANY CHANGES. This is for the safety and security of our participants. Camp Staff, First Aide and Coordinators need to know who and the number of occupants in each cabin and room.

**LUGGAGE:** The Camp Homewood Luggage Van will be on the **4:30pm** sailing. It will on the left-hand side beside the fence.

#### **GROUND RULES**

#### **Code of Conduct:**

- 1. All sessions must be attended by all youth, leaders and chaperones.
- 2. All chaperones must stay with their groups at all times during the conference. When the youth are divided up for Saturday's Retreat/Camp Activities, divide up your chaperones as well.
- 3. There will be important information meetings for chaperones during the Friday night opening session, Saturday morning, afternoon and Sunday morning. ALL youth leaders and chaperones are asked to attend. Terri-Ann and Bonni will post times. Meetings are in the Music Room.
- 4. No participant may leave the conference or billet site unless accompanied by a youth leader or chaperone.
- 5. No cell phones will be permitted to be used during the retreat sessions and Homewood activities. If these are brought to camp, they are done so at your own risk best idea is to leave cell phones at home or with youth group leaders/chaperones during retreat sessions and Homewood group activity time.
- 6. Participants must show respect for others and their property at all times.
- 7. A participant will be dismissed from the Homewood Retreat if he or she is:
  - a. Under the influence, or is in possession of drugs or alcohol
  - b. In the presence of another who is under the influence, or who is clearly in possession of drugs or alcohol
  - c. Behaving abnormally or inappropriately
- 8. If out of town participants are dismissed, it will become the responsibility of their Parish Leader or Chaperone to deal with the situation. *Any costs incurred from dismissal will be the responsibility of the participant's family.*

#### **Dress Code:**

- 1. Clothing that promotes, advertises or makes reference to the following is not permitted:
  - a. Derogatory racial, religious or sexist messages
  - b. Vulgar, abusive and inappropriate language
  - c. Illegal activity
  - d. Drugs, alcohol or tobacco
- 2. No revealing clothing such as halter tops, backless shirts, bare midriffs, spaghetti straps and see through clothing are to be worn during the Retreat. Clothing must cover the entire back, front, shoulders and mid-section at all times.
- 3. No undergarments are to be visible at any time and no pajamas are to be worn outside of sleeping areas.




