2012

AMS Sciences, devoted to R&D, becomes sister company to AMS

- Denton facility comes online with capacity for 3.5 million gallons a year
- Product applied on over 3 million acres



2010

1.8 million gallons of product produced at Pilot Point facility

- Advanced formulation technology launched for concentrated Accomplish & Titan



2007

Launch of Accomplish LM

- Entered into strategic supply agreement with Loveland Products (then propriety products of UAP)
- Advanced Microbial Investors (AMI) invests in AMS



2002

Launch of SoilBuilder, SoilLife product brands



- Recapitalized with current core investor group

1955

Bob Pedigo invents fundamental fermentation process in Pilot Point, TX

- Develops loyal local customer base



2013

AMS Sciences becomes Agricen Sciences, with headquarters in Pilot Point, TX

- AMS becomes Agricen, a Loveland Products company, with headquarters in Frisco, TX
- First commercial product from Denton facility delivered to market
