Cost-your time VS your budget

As a general rule of thumb property managers usually charge between 7 and 9 per cent of the rent collected and any repairs carried out on your behalf.

Cost of a property manager	Dollar value of your time
\$145 per month On average, excluding CST*	The formula: Value of your time per hour / 60 = Value of your time by minute
*Based on the median rent for a 3 bedroom in Hamilton in February 2017.	Example: Hourly wage of \$35 / 60 = 0.58
