

# COVID-19 Retail Supply Chain Update

25.03.2020



- The EC issued 'green lane' guidelines to limit border processing time to 15 minutes for freight movements.
- 40% of US forwarders indicate lay-offs are underway or imminent.
- Amazon will temporarily suspend deliveries of nonessential goods to customers in France, Italy & India.
- Indian ports are operating at severely reduced capacity due to a shortage of drivers and warehouse staff.



# Inter-Europe

While movement continues, some operators are increasing prices to mitigate driver and equipment shortages, as well as costs from covering a round trip with no return cargo..

China limiting inbound flights to avoid reinfection, with 60 inbound flights this week cancelled already. Reduced demand lowering ocean rates.
