Intended Module Learning Outcomes

On successful completion of this module, the learner will be able to:

- 1. Discuss the importance of law to the operation of business in Ireland
- 2. Identify the nature and structure of the Irish legal system
- 3. Explain the essential aspects of the law of contract
- 4. Describe the essential features of the law of negligence
- 5. Explain the basic concepts of insurance and negotiable instruments
- 6. Show an awareness of the legal structure of business, including limited liability and the full life cycle of business from formation to winding up
- 7. Describe the duties and responsibilities of the various officers of the business
- 8. Recognise the key obligations and rights provided by employment law statutes

Module Objectives

This module aims to develop an understanding and knowledge of the general principles of Irish law as it relates to business. It introduces learners to the effect, influence and impact of law in business while providing an understanding of how the Irish legal system is structured and how it operates with particular emphasis on business.

The module enables learners to apply relevant law to practical business situations and to have a broad understanding of the rights and obligations of employees and employers as they relate to business.
