I believe that it is essential for me to be up front and honest regarding all Nook Rx'd operations; therefore, I want each of you to hear from me why we are not affiliated as CrossFit.

Simply stated, CrossFit, Inc. chose not to affiliate with us.

I applied. That application was denied. I pushed back. Still denied.

One of the primary questions CrossFit, Inc. asked of me within the application for affiliation was why do I want to affiliate under the CrossFit brand. Here was my answer:

Roughly six years ago a good friend of mine introduced me to



CrossFit at a young affiliate in Hershey, PA. I was immediately drawn to the community of people that called CrossFit Gamma home. With an intense desire to help people and a love for coaching and training, I obtained my L1 Trainer Certificate roughly a year and a half later.

Four and a half years of coaching has intensified my desire to have a positive impact on the lives of those I coach and train. We will pursue excellence in everything we do.

We will build a community based on the principles of hard work, honor and respect. We will push each other to accomplish things we never thought we could. We will encourage each other when we struggle. And we will celebrate together when we succeed.

I am not sure I can fully put into words the level of excitement I wake up with each day knowing I have this incredible opportunity to bring Nook Rx'd to each of you, to grow this community together. I am blessed and excited to meet and work with each of you!
