

Office 365 Security Health Check



Office 365 provides basic protection against email spam, malware and known viruses. However, as hackers launch increasingly sophisticated and damaging attacks, companies need to implement additional security controls capable of preventing and blocking them.

One of the perks of utilizing a cloud service like Office 365 is that there are new features and functions continuously being rolled out. Microsoft has made great strides in the security tools offered in every Office 365 subscription. Perhaps one of the most helpful is the Office 365 Secure Score.

Secure Score analyzes your Office 365 organization's security based on regular activities and security settings then assigns a score. Think of it as a credit score for security.

Using Secure Score, iV4 conducts a monthly review of the following eleven items, which if left ignored, could result in malicious activity and ultimately a compromised account. Reviewing the components included in the monthly Office 365 Security Health Check is fundamental to prevent an incident from occurring.

Just as you should perform monthly Net Health Checks to make sure backups are running properly and anti-virus patches are rolled out, reviewing your Office 365 tenancy is just as important.

If irregularities are identified, iV4 will make recommendations on additional security implementations to remediate issues.
