AMERICAN CONSUMERS GIVE TOP MARKS TO HEALTHCARE COMPANIES SHIRE, SANOFI AND BAYER

Healthcare industry achieved an overall strong reputation in Reputation Institute's survey as pharmaceutical companies dominate the list

BOSTON AND COPENHAGEN (June 18, 2015) – Reputation Institute today released the list of America's top 25 most reputable companies in the healthcare industry. Seven of the top ten companies in the list are pharmaceutical companies and three are medical device companies.

"Sweeping changes in the U.S. healthcare industry have not dented the reputation of the companies in this space," said Brad Hecht, chief research officer at Reputation Institute. "The overall reputation of the healthcare industry in the United States is stronger than ever, moving from an average reputation to a strong reputation this year."

"The most reputable healthcare companies recognize that even though products and services are important and constitute 15 percent of their reputations, nearly half of their reputation is attributable to their corporate social responsibility efforts."

Twenty-one of the top 25 companies in the healthcare industry achieved a "strong" reputation, though none achieved an "excellent" reputation. The top three companies – Shire, Sanofi, and Bayer – were virtually on par at 77.55, 76.16, and 75.83, respectively.
