## **EDINBURGH NAMED SIXTH IN LARGEST WORLD'S MOST REPUTABLE CITIES SURVEY, WHILE SYDNEY TAKES THE TOP SPOT**

***Reputation Institute's City RepTrak® identified most reputable cities based on perceptions of economy, environment and government.***

**LONDON (Nov. 3, 2016)** – Sydney, Australia, and Vienna, Austria, have claimed the top spots in Reputation Institute's 2016 City RepTrak®, the world's largest annual survey of city reputations. Sydney takes the first spot for the second year in a row, followed by Vienna in a very close second place. Vienna is climbing quickly, having improved in the rankings from fourth place in 2015 to second in 2016. Canada has three cities in the top ten, including Toronto, Montreal, and Vancouver. Edinburgh was the only UK city to claim a place in the top ten, with London falling outside of the top 20.

“For city reputation, the competition at the top is only getting stronger,” said Nicolas Georges Trad, Executive Partner at Reputation Institute. “For the first time in the City RepTrak® study we have cities with an “excellent” reputation (i.e. scoring more than 80 out of a possible 100 points). Reputation is an important issue for local policymakers concerned about tourism, relocation and investment, as there is a direct link between a city's reputation and people's willingness to visit, work and live there. By focusing on the key factors that drive overall reputation, cities can improve their reputation scores and benefit from increased support from their stakeholders (from tourists to central Governments).”

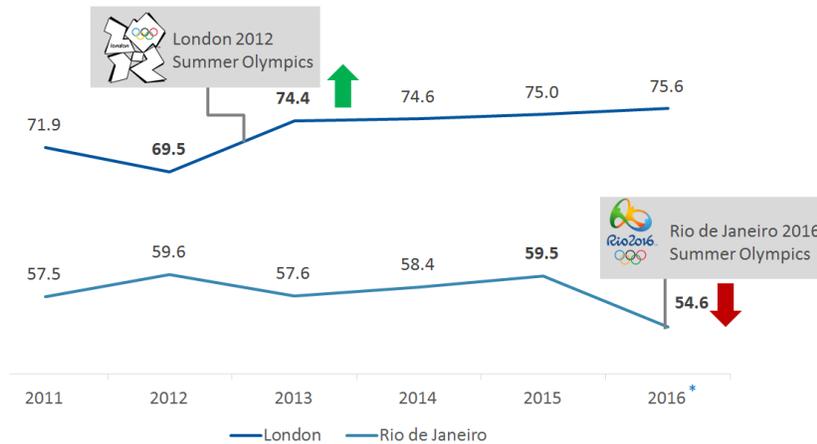
City RepTrak® is a global survey based on more than 22,000 consumer ratings, collected in the G8 countries, which ranks the world's 55 most reputable cities based on levels of trust, esteem, admiration and respect. Perceptions are then grouped into three dimensions: Advanced Economy, Effective Government and Appealing Environment. Cities with strong reputations are perceived positively in all three dimensions.

Zurich, Toronto, Montreal, and Rome are new to the Top 10 in 2016 compared with 2015, while London has failed to gain a place in the top ten since 2014. Thirteen of the top 20 cities in the 2016 City RepTrak® are European, with Vienna the highest of this group.

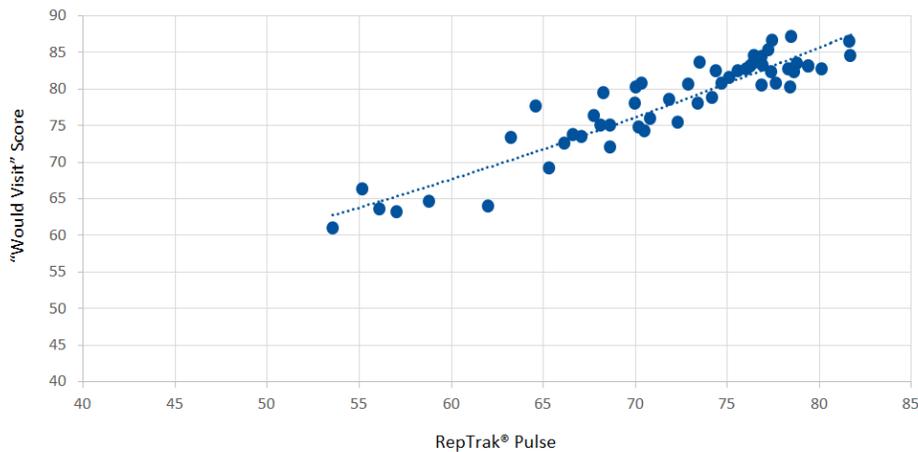

Hosting the Olympics has a positive reputational lift for cities that are strong economically and politically, and a negative effect for those who lack stability. For London, the 2012 Summer Olympics had a positive effect on the city's reputation, with the capital enjoying the afterglow since then.

In contrast, the impact of the 2016 Olympics on the reputation of Rio de Janeiro in Rio the story is very different. Rio's score dropped by 5 points right after the Olympics ended. Brazil's political, economic and health crises set an unstable stage for the Games, and the many infrastructure and organisational issues covered by global media only exasperated this.



The value created by a strong reputation is undeniable, as the cities with the highest reputations attract the most visitors.



The cities that have the best reputations are also the ones that people would most like to live, work in, invest in and visit, as seen below (those in blue feature in the top 10 of the reputation ranking):
