Establish a Network of Community Resources	<p>Partnerships with community and faith-based organization will create a network of resources that will directly benefit Pre-Kindergarten families as needed. Some resources are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Little Free Library provided by United Way (One box is located at the Tower Elementary campus and the second location is the Hardin Administrative Office at 100 N Avenue D.) • STEM curricular activities provided through a Priddy Foundation grant • School supplies provided by Project Back-to-School • Muffins with Mom (Evans) school program • Donuts with Dad (Evans) school program
3. Increase Family Participation in Decision-Making	<p>Pre-Kindergarten Families will be invited to participate and serve on district committees such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Campus Improvement Teams • Survey on effectiveness of Pre-K Family Engagement Plan for continuous improvement • Parent-Teacher conferences • Campus PTOs
