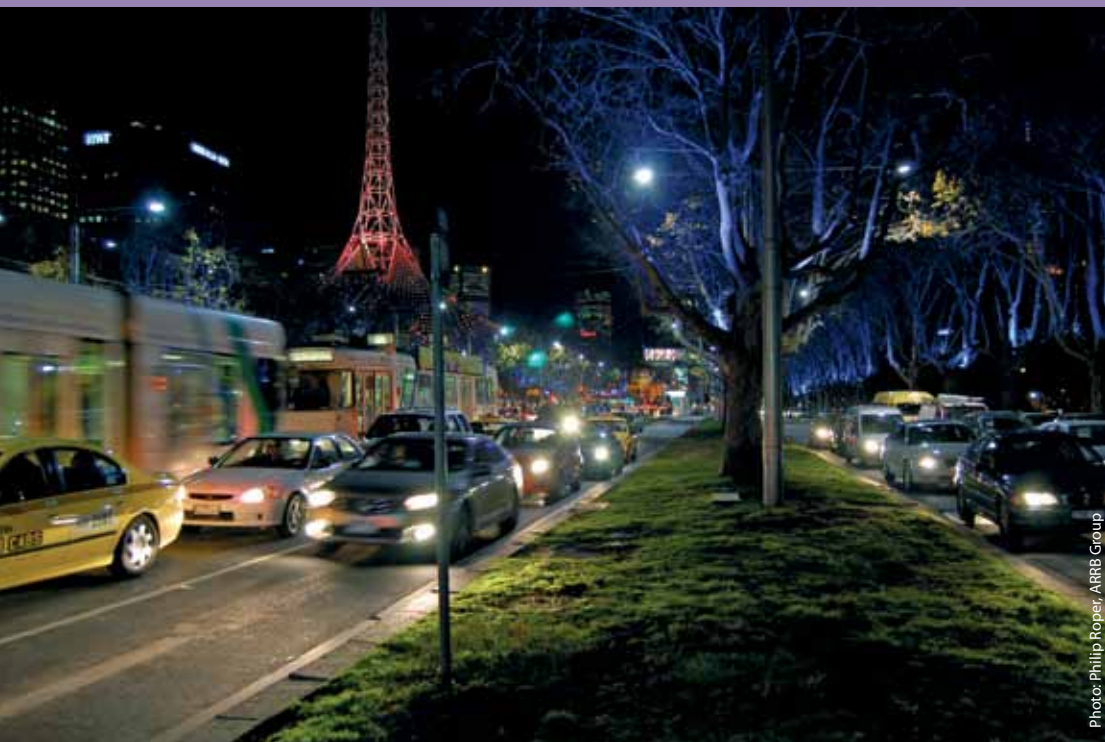

About the Conferences

For almost 50 years ARRB Conferences have promoted discussion of issues relevant to the transport industry, and new research being undertaken on the local and international scene. In 2010, ARRB is hosting the 2nd International Sprayed Sealing Conference and the 24th ARRB Conference.

The 2nd International Sprayed Sealing Conference: sustaining sprayed sealing practice will focus on maintenance of sprayed seal performance in a climate of increasing expectations and demands, combined with depletion of known quality materials. It will contribute to the continued development of sprayed sealing procedures and technologies which are vital to improving the performance of a significant proportion of the road transport system.

The 24th ARRB Conference: building on 50 years of road and transport research aims to bring together road and transport research advances from around Australia and the rest of the world. The 2010 conference will focus on research outcomes which address the key emerging issues affecting the road and transport industry, and the global community. The ARRB Conference has been a biennial event since the first conference in Canberra in 1962. This Conference coincides with the celebration of ARRB Group's 50th Anniversary.

The 24th ARRB Conference will be held immediately after the 2nd International Sprayed Sealing Conference to allow delegates to get the most out of their visit to Melbourne. A reduced registration rate applies to delegates attending both.

2nd International Sprayed Sealing Conference

Keynote speaker Mr Dennis Rossmann, South African National Roads Agency (SANRAL) - will present on Imperatives in sustaining sprayed sealing practice.

Technical tour (Sunday 10 October)

The Sprayed Sealing Conference Technical Tour will showcase a visit to ARRB's research facilities in Vermont South, where participants will have an opportunity to tour ARRB's bitumen laboratories. The Tour will feature a visit to ARRB's full scale pavement testing research laboratory, currently testing a two coat emulsion seal on a granular base, and demonstration of a spray run using the French synchronised spraying / spreading method. The tour will commence at the Conference venue, and includes lunch. Further information on the Technical Tour is available on the conference website.

24th ARRB Conference

Keynote address Building on 50 years of road and transport research

Plenary sessions The ARRB Conference will showcase three plenary sessions, as outlined below. Information about invited speakers (and further information about plenary sessions) will be updated on the conference website as they are confirmed.

Towards a sustainable road system - Transport is a long term endeavour. It is also vital to the social and economic well-being of society and therefore needs to be sustainable. However, thought is seldom given to what constitutes sustainability. This session will examine the meaning of sustainability in the roads and transport context, particularly in relation to sustainable network capacity, resources, fuel and emissions futures.

Maximising network productivity and the case for road pricing - As the usage requirements of our road network grow, differing approaches to network management practices require consideration in order to facilitate ongoing improvements. This session will examine factors that influence current and emerging network demand and possible responses, particularly road pricing.

Integrating safety outcomes - The Safe System approach has been adopted across Australia. This approach has implications for road safety practitioners, as well as all others involved in managing roads. This session will explore an integrated approach to planning and managing road assets whilst delivering improved road safety outcomes.

Technical tours (Tuesday 12 October)

Tours commence at the Conference venue, and include lunch. Further information on the Technical Tours are available on the conference website.

Red Technical Tour - M1 Freeway Management Systems (Network operations and safety) - This tour will showcase the M1 Upgrade, featuring operational and safety features of the project. The tour includes a visit to the M1 project office, where participants will have an opportunity to see the intelligent freeway management system in action. The tour will also include a visit to ARRB's research facilities in Vermont South.

Blue Technical Tour - Eastlink tollway and Accelerated Loading Facility (Asset management and pavement research) - This tour will showcase aspects of the construction and operation of the Eastlink tollway that take into consideration key asset management activities and pavement design issues. It will include a visit to ARRB's full scale pavement testing research laboratory and to ARRB's research facilities in Vermont South.

Conference dinner The dinner is being held on Wednesday 13 October at the National Gallery of Victoria (Great Hall).

Interchange function The ARRB Conference Interchange (informal drinks and nibbles) will be held on Thursday 14 October at the Melbourne Museum.
