About the Conference

ARRB Group is hosting the 3rd International Road Surface Friction Conference (15 – 18 May 2011) in Gold Coast, Australia in association with NZTA and WDM®. The 2011 conference aims to build upon the technical quality and après conference enjoyment and camaraderie of the previous conferences in Christchurch, New Zealand (2005) and Cheltenham, UK (2008).
