

DIY SOD



INSTALLATION

Burn calories and bond with your new lawn by installing it yourself.

TEST

Conduct a soil test and send it to Waters Agricultural Labs to determine which nutrients your soil needs before laying sod.



SPRAY

Kill off the existing vegetation in your lawn with a kill-all herbicide.

CALL

Call Super-Sod to place your order for sod and Soil3 compost. Call at least 3 days in advance.



TILL & TOSS

When old vegetation is dead, till up your lawn. Rake up and toss debris.

DELIVERY

We'll drop off your sod and cubic yard BigYellowBags of Soil3 organic compost.

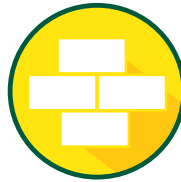


SPREAD

Spread the Soil3 organic compost across your lawn then rake it into your existing soil. Apply additional nutrients if needed.

LAY

Unstack the sod and lay it in a brick-like pattern, butting edges tightly together.



WATER

Water the sod as you lay it so your pieces don't dry out.

SHAPE

Use a shovel to slice edges and fill in gaps to achieve your desired lawn shape.



KEEP WATERING

Water, water, water! Keep the sod moist until it's established and rooted into the soil, then gradually cut back on the watering.

ENJOY

Sit back, relax, and enjoy being the envy of your neighborhood.
