FedRAMP is put in place to help provide a standard way to assess, monitor and authorize cloud-based products and services to meet the elite security standards upheld by federal agencies.

Additionally, ER will be required to pass an independent re-assessment every year and have demonstrated compliance with security control standards set by the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Special Publication 800-53 Revision 4.
