# Governance and Management



- Relationship and Accountabilities
  - Governance is in the Grandstand
  - Management is on the playing field
  - Governance is constantly assessing the performance
  - Governance delegates to Management
  - Delegation with Feedback and confirmation is the key

### Board



- Questions:
  - Who is going to prison?
  - Who is going to tell their family? That we were too busy to care!
- Culture of openness
- Prompt advice on serious accidents and injuries
- Communications/Media Policy
  - Who talks to the media?
  - Who talks to the internal team?

## Risks/Weaknesses



- Celebrate every weakness/risk identified
- Eliminate or minimise
- Weaknesses and risks identified are a good thing (positively communicate)
- Risks increase with the level of education 'intellectual arrogance'

## Rules



- Non-negotiable
  - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Send very strong positive & consistent messages

- No documentation
  - No proof you care
- Management trail
- Governance trail

# **Board Reporting**



- Board Annual Workplan
- H&S Committee
  - Committee representation needs to be signed off by the Board
  - Confirm meeting frequency
  - Confirm meeting agenda
  - Term of appointment & rotation
- Confirm Hazards/Risks assessed
- Accident/incident
  - Number lost time
  - Number non-lost time
  - Near Misses
  - Outcomes
- Training and awareness
  - IoD Guidance (Guides, Checklist)
  - Governance & Operational training
- Capital requests

### **Internal Audits**



- Regular hazard & risks assessments
- Use range of people (compliance vs. improvement)
- Audit each others departments

## **General Awareness**



- Examples
  - Electricity on the ground
  - Valve radios
  - Cigarette butts in a cardboard box in the paper store
